THE LARGEST LUXURY CHARTER GULET BUILT TO DATE IN BODRUM



Regina is the latest ship build from Pruva Yachting and has set a new standard of quality, luxury and size for charter gulets throughout Turkey and Greece. Built to RINA classification, she has an enforced steel hull and is suitable for ocean sailing.



49 meter luxury gulet REGINA can accommodate 12 guests in 6 cabins including 3 master cabins all with a separate dressing rooms, fitted with Satellite TV, DVD and music system. The remaining cabins are also very spacious and comfortable and include 1 double, 1 twin and a single cabin.

Her classical décor features clear mahogany wood and white lacquered surfaces. The expansive saloon features a lounging area, across from the TV, a large circular dining table as well as a baby grand piano. This area features ample natural light and is finished with neutral soft tones.

Above deck are forward and aft dining areas, each with a capacity of up to 12 guests. The beautiful, roomy forward deck has ample space for lounging and is a completely flat deck fitted with Burmese teak.

The crew of 8 include an internationally recognized chef with world cuisines prepared in the spacious galley.

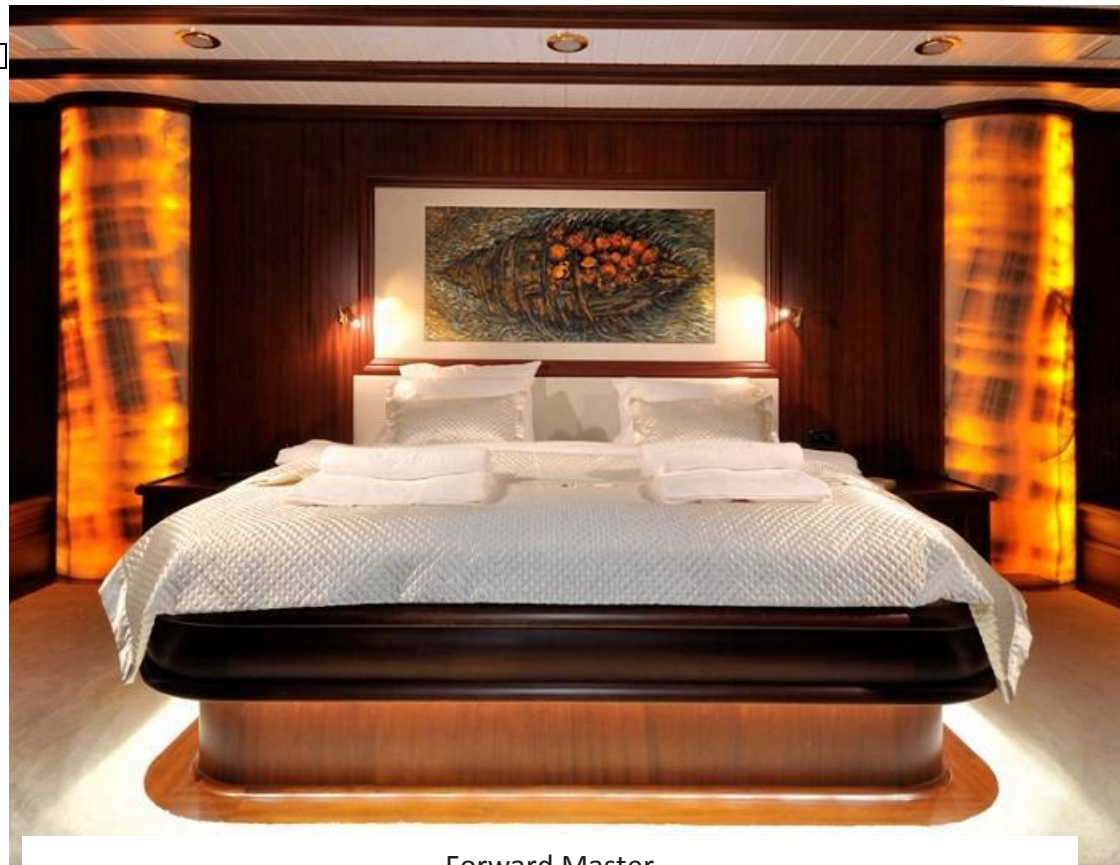

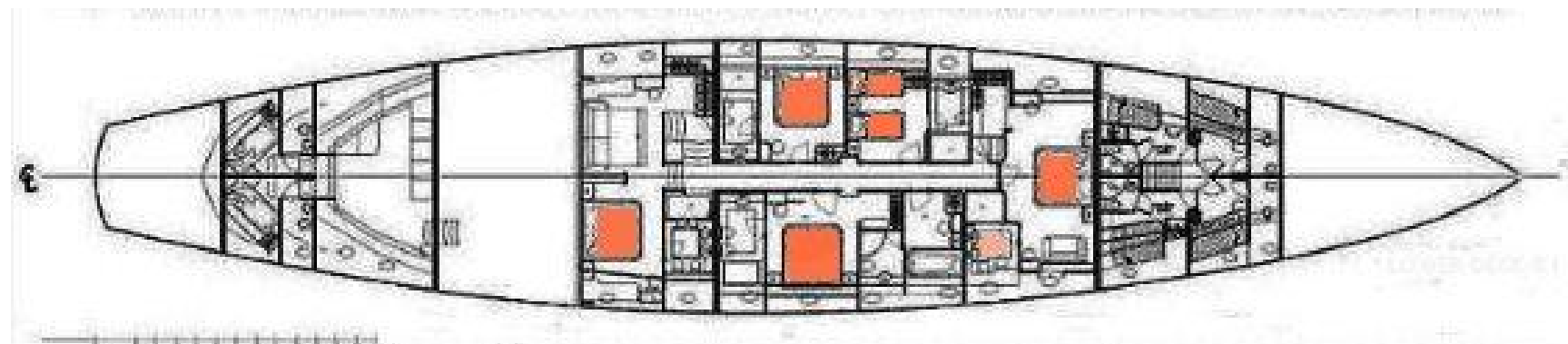
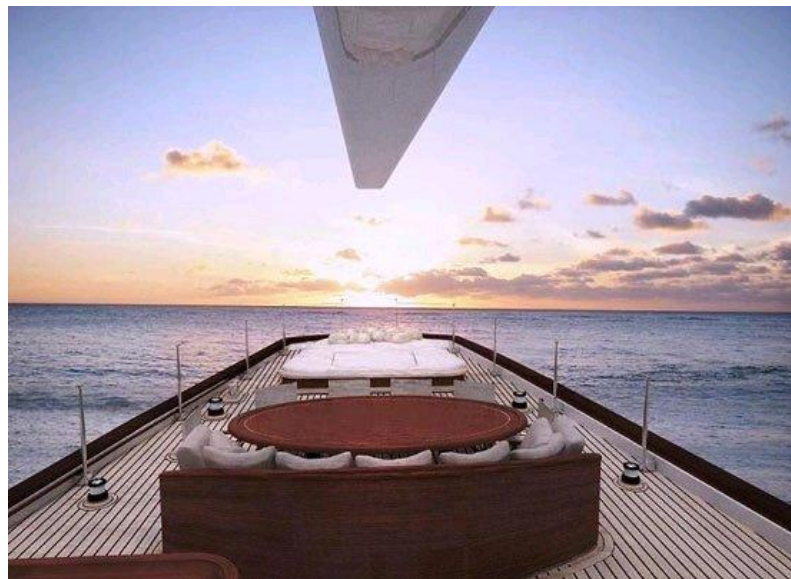
